WHEREAS by a certain indenture of lease in writing dated the 30th day of June, 1922, the Lessor did grant, decise and lease unto the Lessoe the lands and premises hereinafter more particularly described to have and to hold the same for and during the term of fearteen (14) years computed from the First day of January, 1922.

and lease for a term of twenty-one (21) years from the First day of January, 1926, being the date of expiry of said lease and for a further renewal for a term of twenty-one (21) years from the First day of January, 1957.

AMP UNHABLE the Lessor has agreed with the Lessoe to demise and lesso the hereinafter mentioned lands for a further term of twenty-one (A1) years, to commende on the First day of January, 1925, and for an additional further term of twenty-one (A1) years from the First day of January, 1927, subject to the covenants, terms and provisions as contained in said lesso dates 50th June, 1922, except the provision as to rental which shall be at the rate hereinafter provides for.

P. No. S; thence S. 890 59 * 30" a distance of 1552.0 feet to a planted iron post marked G. T. P.
